

This year Windsor will be hosting the OFSAA West Regional Track and Field Championships on May 30th and 31st. In order for the meet to run smoothly we require a minimum of seventy-five student volunteers. We would like to offer this opportunity to WECSSAA Track and Field athletes and students from physical education leadership classes. If you know of any athletes who might not be competing at the meet or of other students in your school who would like to volunteer we are now accepting names. There will also be a registration form at the WECSSAA and SWOSSAA meets in the press box. Each volunteer will be given an OFSAA West Regional Championship tech-fit shirt as well as food throughout the meet. They will need to arrive at 12:00pm on Friday June 1st and work until the meet ends around 7:45pm. They are required to arrive around 8:30am on Saturday and stay until the meet ends around 4:00pm. Depending on the number of volunteers that register, shifts will be given in order for volunteers to have a break and allow them to watch events and/or leave if they choose to do so.
